The Kenosha Police Department is excited to provide Public Safety for the Festival Foods 4th of July Fireworks display.

Twitter will be KPD's main public communication source on the 4th of July. KPD Facebook will mirror the Twitter updates.

There will also be a Police Public Information tent set up on 1st Avenue between 54th and 55th streets by the museums. The tent will be clearly marked with Police banners and there will be a yellow and white strobe on top of the tent making it visible to the public. This location will serve as a lost and found, a child reunification site should one become separated from their parents, and a general source of information for the public.

“Public Safety for the event is our top priority. There will be over 60 uniformed police officers, specifically assigned to the lakefront venue to provide assistance to the public as needed.” said Interim Police Chief Eric Larsen. “We want to be accessible and to provide a designated location for spectator convenience should they lose an item or need to be reunited with their lost child. The Public Information tent will serve that purpose, and I urge the public to follow us on Twitter to access accurate, up to date information.”
