### How do I get Started?

Visit MyVote.WI.gov for all your election needs!

### Vote Absentee by Mail

You must be registered to vote at your current address to request an absentee ballot. Upload a valid photo ID. **No Selfies!**

### Where do I Vote?

Your assigned polling place is based on where you live. Type in your address, it will show you where to vote.

### What's on My Ballot?

Sample ballots are available 47 days before a federal election and 21 days before state and local elections.

### Register to Vote or Update Name and Address

Your address on file with the DMV must be up to date for online registration.

### I don't have Access to the Internet

Register to vote or request an absentee ballot at the City Clerk's Office. If you would like the forms mailed to you call (262) 653-4020.

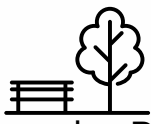

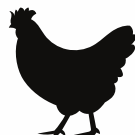
