KENOSHA – Kenosha residents are reminded that no banners, signs, decorations or obstructions are allowed in the public right-of-way, per City ordinance, without first receiving permission in writing from the Director of Public Works.

People who are found in violation of the ordinance may be subject to a fine of up to \$300 per day. The City also removes the signs or other obstructions from the public right-of-way.
