Please note that buses shall be considered non-operable nor road-worthy, and have been equipped with "No Value Tires". Therefore, buses would need to be flatbedded, trailered and/or towed by the successful bidders.

Buses and components shall be paid for prior to or at the time that the bus(es) are scheduled for retrieval. Payment shall be by submission of either a cashiers or certified check to the Department of Finance, Municipal Office Building, Room 208, 625-52nd Street. Kenosha, WI. 53140 prior to the retrieval of any surplus asset.

Successful bidders shall provide verification that at time of sale they 1) received the signed-over title to the buses from the City of Kenosha, and 2) that they took possession of the signed-over title and acknowledged its transfer by providing their signature.
