KENOSHA- The City of Kenosha Municipal Office Building will be closed Thursday and Friday, November 24 and 25 for the Thanksgiving Holiday.

There will be NO curbside garbage, recycling, brush, yard waste, tire, TV, or bulk collection Thursday, November 24. Waste and recycling collection for all items will be delayed one day for Thursday's and Friday's routes ONLY. Thursday's route will be collected on Friday and Friday's route will be collected Saturday.

The yard waste drop off site, 4071-88th Ave., will be closed on Thursday, November 24 in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday. The yard waste site will reopen on Friday, November 25 for the regular hours of operation of 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. The yard waste drop-off site will be open through Saturday, December 3.

The City of Kenosha Bulk Waste Drop-Off Site, 1001-50th Street, will be closed Thursday, November 24. The site will be open for normal operations, Friday, November 25 from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturday, November 26 from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The Concrete and Brick/Block Drop-Off Site, 6415 35th Avenue, will be CLOSED Thursday, November 24. It will re-open on Friday, November 25 for its normal hours of operations from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

If you have bulk garbage, televisions, appliances or tires that need to be picked up, please call the Public Works Department at 653-4050 a minimum of one working day before your regular collection day when the office is open.
