KENOSHA- The City of Kenosha Commission on the Arts and the Kenosha Community Foundation will present a community-led arts conversation beginning at 6 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 19 at Fusion, 5014 7th Ave.

The event, Kenosha Rising, was developed in partnership with the University of Wisconsin Extension and Expose Kenosha. It is sponsored by the Kenosha Community Foundation as part of Community Foundation Week.

Jeremy Fojut of Milwaukee will talk about his involvement with NEWaukee, a social architecture firm that incorporates creativity with community programs in the arts in the metro Milwaukee area.

Amy Greil of the UW-Extension will present the results from the first phase of Kenosha Rising, a broad-based community survey of Kenosha County residents and their views on the community arts scene.
