

Licensing/Permit Committee
Minutes of Meeting Held November 9, 2009

A meeting of the Licensing/Permit Committee was held on November 9, 2009 in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building.

The meeting was called to order at 6:21pm by Chairman Misner.

At roll call, the following members were present: Aldermen Juliana, Kennedy, and Nudo. Deputy City Attorney Matthew Knight was present. Alderman Downing was excused.

It was moved by Alderman Juliana, seconded by Alderman Nudo to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held October 26, 2009. Motion carried unanimously.

1. Applications for new Operator's (Bartender) licenses, with a recommendation from the City Attorney to grant, subject to:

-25 demerit points:

It was moved by Alderman Kennedy, seconded by Alderman Juliana, to concur with the recommendation of the City Attorney. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Applications for new Operator's (Bartender) licenses, with a recommendation from the City Attorney to deny, based on:

It was moved by Alderman Kennedy, seconded by Alderman Juliana to separate the items. Motion carried unanimously. It was moved by Alderman Kennedy, seconded by Alderman Nudo to approve a subject to 95 demerit points. Alderman Kennedy moved to amend his motion, seconded by Alderman Juliana, to approve a subject to 75 demerit points. Motion carried unanimously. It was moved by Alderman Nudo, seconded by Alderman Kennedy to concur with the recommendation of the City Attorney to deny b. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Application of Joseph Fligleman for a new Operator's (Bartender) license, with a recommendation from the City Attorney to defer. (Deferred from the meeting of October 26, 2009)
Joseph Fligleman was present and spoke. **It was moved by Alderman Kennedy, seconded by Alderman Juliana, to defer for further review by the City Attorney's office, to the meeting on November 30, 2009. Motion carried unanimously.**
4. Application of Enrique Quiala for a new Taxi Driver license, with a recommendation from the City Attorney to deny, based on material police record & false application. (*Deferred from the meeting of September 28, 2009*)
It was moved by Alderman Juliana, seconded by Alderman Kennedy, to concur with the recommendation of the City Attorney to deny. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Application of Glen Ritacca for a new Taxi Driver's license, with a recommendation from the City Attorney to grant, subject to 40 demerit points.

Application of the McCool Corporation, Shawn McHugh, Agent, for a Class "B" Beer/"Class B" Liquor License located at 1400 52nd Street, (Jill's Place), with acceptance of a conditional surrender of a similar license at the same location from Jill's Place Inc. subject to 50 demerit points, to be effective November 17, 2009. *(7th District)*
Shawn McHugh and Jill Rzeplinski were present and spoke. **It was moved by Alderman Juliana, seconded by Alderman Kennedy, to approve subject to 50 demerit points. Motion carried unanimously.**
7. Application of The Barn LLC, located at 4017 80th Street, (Bull & Bear Eatery) for a Cabaret License (1-year term) with no adverse recommendation. *(14th District)*
Chris Gochis was present and spoke. Alderman Dan Prozanski was present and spoke in support of applicant. **It was moved by Alderman Juliana, seconded by Alderman Kennedy, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.**
8. Application of August Grulich for a Secondhand Article Dealer's License located at 2231 63rd Street, (Kenosha New Hope Mission, Inc.) *(12th District)*
August Grulich was present and spoke. **It was moved by Alderman Juliana, seconded by Alderman Kennedy, to defer for further review by the City Attorney's office, to a special meeting on November 16, 2009. Motion carried unanimously.**
