Minutes of Meeting Held Monday, September 29, 2008

A meeting of the Licensing/Permit Committee was held on Monday, September 29, 2008 in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Misner.

12. By Alderperson Don Moldenhauer – To Repeal and Recreate Section 5.045 J.3.e. of the Code of General Ordinances; and, to Repeal and Recreate Sections 10.075 E.1. and E.2. of the Code of General Ordinances, Regarding Cabaret Licenses and Amplified Music or Sound in an Outdoor Area of a Premises Holding a "Class B", Class "B" and/or "Class C" License. (Deferred from the meeting of August 25, 2008)

It was moved by Alderman Dowling, seconded by Alderman Kennedy to defer for two weeks. Motion carried unanimously.

13. Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations in the Matter of the Class "B" Beer/"Class B" Liquor License of Kick's Rhythm & Blues, LLC, Kimberly Jenkins, Agent, Located at 2901-60th Street, (Kick's Rhythm & Blues).

Attorney Edward Antaramian (Deputy City Attorney) and Attorney Frederick Zeebers were present and spoke. It was moved by Alderman Juliana, seconded by Alderman Nudo to suspend for 30 days and reinstate with 95 demerit pts. Motion carried unanimously.

14. Discussion regarding taxi cab and transportation service legislation.

Tina White (Keno Cab), Linda Orsburn (Ktown Transportation), and Southport Transportation were present. An ordinance will be drafted for the Licensing/Permit Committee and come in front on October 27, 2008.

CITIZENS/ALDERMEN COMMENTS: Tina White (Keno Cab), Linda Orsburn (Ktown Transportation), and Southport Transportation briefly talked regarding the taxi cab service. Tina Burns briefly talked about her bartender license being denied.

There being no further business to come before the Licensing/Permit Committee, it was moved, seconded and unanimously carried to adjourn at 7:25 pm.
