Monday, December 27, 2010

The regular meeting of the Public Safety & Welfare Committee was held on Monday, December 27, 2010 in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm. The following members were present: Chairman Downing, Alderman Orth and LaMacchia. Alderman Kennedy and Green were excused. Staff members in attendance were Kevin Risch and Carol Stancato.

It was moved by Alderman LaMacchia, seconded by Alderman Orth, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on Monday, December 13, 2010. Motion passed 3-0.

- B-1. Aldermanic request for a 4 Way Stop for 62nd Place and 95th Avenue.
(District 17) (Staff recommends denial) (Deferred from the meeting held on December 13, 2010)
Public Hearing: Alderman Bogdala, 17th District, was present to answer any questions.
Staff/Alderman: Kevin recommended denial that the criteria didn't justify having a 4 way stop.
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman LaMacchia, to deny. Motion passed 3-0.
- B-2. Proposed Ordinance To Repeal and Recreate Various Sections of Chapter 15 Related to Off-Premises Signs. *(Referred back from Common Council meeting of December 6, 2010) (Deferred from the meeting held on December 13, 2010)*
Public Hearing: Jason Saari, Adams Outdoor Advertising, 102 E Badger Rd, Madison, WI 53713, was present to answer any questions. Mark Rausch, Clear Channel, 908 Silvernail Rd, Pewaukee, WI 53072, was present to answer any questions.
Staff/Alderman: The committee would like to meet with the two sign companies to make adjustments to this proposed ordinance.
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman LaMacchia, to defer 30 days. Motion passed 3-0.
