

MINUTES
January 25, 2016
Licensing/Permit Committee

A meeting of the Licensing/Permit Committee was held on January 25, 2016, in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Vice-Chairperson Patrick Juliana.

At roll call, the following members were present: Alderpersons Wicklund, Bogdala and Ruffolo. Chairperson Wilson was excused. Deputy City Attorney Matt Knight was present.

Citizen Comments – KPD Chief Morrissey spoke regarding the significant amount of calls for service to Brat Stop Too, and the establishment has become a concern to residents and surrounding businesses. He requested that Brat Stop Too be called before the Licensing/Permit Committee for discussion of their activities.

Approval of the minutes of the regular meeting held January 11, 2016.

It was moved by Alderperson Wicklund, seconded by Alderperson Bogdala to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Application of Red Iguana By Rosie's, LLC, for a Yearly Cabaret License located at 4814 Sheridan Rd., (Red Iguana By Rosie's), with an adverse recommendation from the Police Department. (District 2) (Deferred from the meeting on January 4, 2016)

Applicant was present and spoke. Alderperson Juliana passed the gavel and spoke. Alderperson Wicklund spoke. Attorney Knight spoke. It was moved by Alderperson Juliana, seconded by Alderperson Wicklund to deny based on 1) substantial negative impact to surrounding properties and neighborhood, 2) existing plan character of neighborhood, 3) applicants compliance and performance of licensing laws, and 4) false application. Motion carried unanimously.

He also inquired as to why the additional deferment of the Brat Stop revocation hearing hadn't been handled through the committee. He proposed that a policy on deferment actions be put on the agenda as a discussion item. Alderperson Wicklund thanked Chief Morrissey for bringing Brat Stop Too to the attention of the committee. Alderperson Ruffolo stated that all licensed establishments involved in revocation hearings should be treated equally.

There being no further business to come before the Licensing/Permit Committee, it was moved, seconded and unanimously carried to adjourn at 7:07 p.m.





A "Class C" License may not be issued to a foreign corporation, a foreign liability company or a person acting as agent for or in the employ of another.

D. Retail "Class A" Liquor Licenses.

1. Upon receipt of an application for a new Retail "Class A" License, or transfer of any such license under Section 125.04(12)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, the City Clerk/ Treasurer shall send copies thereof to the Department of Community Development and Inspections, the Fire Department, the Health Department, and Police Department. The Department of Community Development and Inspections, the Fire Department, and Health Department, either jointly or severally, within ten (10) days of receiving such copies, shall make a report, in writing, to the Committee on Licenses/Permits, as to whether the premises meet the requirements of this Chapter and the Building, Zoning, Fire, and Health Codes. The Police Department shall report, in writing, to the City Attorney as to any police record of the applicant for a new license (not a statutory transfer of a license), which may reflect upon good moral character or business responsibility. The City Attorney shall examine said record and make a recommendation to the Committee on Licenses/Permits based thereon as to whether or not the license should be granted.

~~2~~ Along with any application for a "Class A" License, or transfer of any such license under Section 125.04(12)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, the applicant shall file with the City Clerk/Treasurer an Economic Impact Statement estimating the impact of the license, if issued, upon the City economy. The Economic Impact Statement shall identify the ownership, value, and square footage of the premises to be licensed; estimate the number of persons to be employed full time and the number of persons to be employed on a part time basis; estimate the gross monthly revenue by each of the following categories: "alcoholic beverages", "Class A beverages", "food", "other"; and the basis for all estimates given. The information submitted shall be true, correct and complete in all material respects. Should the license be granted, or transferred and issued, and the licensee fails to achieve a minimum of seventy (70%) percent of the gross revenue estimated by applicant during the first full license term from the date the license is granted or transferred, the license may be suspended, revoked or not renewed. This paragraph shall not apply to renewals of existing licenses, after the first full license year, or to conditional surrenders of existing licenses, coupled with a new application for a license at the same location.







NOW COMES DEBRA SALAS, City Clerk/Treasurer for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and hereby states and complains as follows:

1. Debra Salas is an adult resident of the State of Wisconsin, and is the City Clerk/Treasurer for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin;
2. Norma Rasmussen, agent of Brat Stop, Inc., d/b/a Brat Stop, hereinafter "Licensee", at all times mentioned herein, was and is an adult resident of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and as of April 15, 2014, resided at 6042 – 41st Avenue, Kenosha, Wisconsin;
3. Licensee was initially granted a Class "B" Beer/"Class B" Liquor Combination License, hereinafter "License", by the Common Council for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Council", pursuant to Chapter 10 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin;
4. The Licensee has filed renewal applications for each successive year with its most recent renewal application for renewal of the Class "B" Beer/ "Class B" Liquor Combination License dated April 15, 2015, for the licensing period beginning on July 1, 2015 and concluding on June 30, 2016.
5. Licensee was granted an Amusement and Recreation Enterprise License for the 2015/2016 licensing term by Council on May 4, 2015, pursuant to Chapter 12 of the Code of General Ordinances subject to a nonrenewal revocation hearing.

6. The Licensee had its Class "B" Beer/ "Class B" Liquor Combination License renewed by Council on May 18, 2015, subject to a nonrenewal revocation hearing;

7. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon citations issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Karl Sovich, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute §125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 D.1. and 10.063 D.6., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on November 21, 2013, resulting with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court on December 12, 2013;

8. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon citations issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Elizabeth Raymer, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute § 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 D.1., 10.063 D.6. and 10.063 D.8., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 21, 2014, resulting with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court on May 19, 2014;

9. That Licensee was assessed fifteen (15) demerit points based upon citations issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Elizabeth Raymer, for Permitting an Underage Person to Loiter on License Premises, contrary to Wisconsin Statute §125.07(3)(b), pursuant to Sections 10.063 D.1. and 10.063 D.6., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 21, 2014, resulting with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court on May 19, 2014;

10. That Licensee was assessed twenty (20) demerit points based upon a citation issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Elizabeth Ortiz, for Sale of Alcohol to an Intoxicated Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute §125.07(2), pursuant to Sections 10.063 D.1. and 10.063 D.6., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on June 1, 2014, with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on August 5, 2014;

11. That Licensee has accumulated one hundred ten (110) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days pursuant to Section 10.063 of the General Code of Ordinances;

12. Pursuant to Section 10.063 D.2.a., of the Code of General Ordinances, the accumulation of one hundred (100) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days subjects the Licensee to the nonrenewal, revocation or suspension of said License held by Licensee, as determined by Council.

AMUSEMENT AND RECREATION ENTERPRISE LICENSE

13. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon citations issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Karl Sovich, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute §125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Section 12.01 B.3.a.(1)(a), of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on November 21, 2013, resulting with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court on December 12, 2013;

14. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon citations issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Elizabeth Raymer, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute § 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Section 12.01 B.3.a.(1)(a), of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 21, 2014, resulting with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court on May 19, 2014;

15. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon citations issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Elizabeth Raymer, for Permitting an Underage Person to Loiter on License Premises, contrary to Wisconsin Statute §125.07(3)(b), pursuant to Section 12.01 B.3.a.(1)(a), of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 21, 2014, resulting with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court on May 19, 2014;

16. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a citation issued to Licensee and Licensee's employee, Elizabeth Ortiz, for Sale of Alcohol to an Intoxicated Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute §125.07(2), pursuant to Section 12.01 B.3.a.(1)(a), of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on June 1, 2014, with a conviction of Licensee's employee in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on August 5, 2014;

17. That Licensee has accumulated one hundred (100) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days pursuant to Section 12.01 of the Code of General Ordinances;

18. Pursuant to Section 12.01 B.3.a., of the Code of General Ordinances, the accumulation of one hundred (100) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days subjects the Licensee to nonrenewal, revocation or suspension of its Amusement and Recreation Enterprise License, as determined by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, Complainant requests the suspension and/or revocation of the Class "B" Beer/"Class B" Liquor Combination License of the Licensee; and the suspension and/or revocation of the Amusement and Recreation Enterprise License of the Licensee.


