MINUTES OF MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 22, 2011

1. The regular Police & Fire Commission meeting was called to order by President Ingrouille at 7:59 a.m. on Tuesday, February 22, 2011. The meeting was held in room 202 of the Municipal Office Building. On roll call, commission members Todd Ingrouille, Peni Keeling, Ron Frederick, Charles Bradley and Helen Schumacher were present.
2. Secretary Frederick made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held January 18, 2011. Vice President Keeling seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
3. Citizen's comments:

4. Vice President Keeling made a motion to receive and file Police and Fire Department Reports for the month of January, 2011. Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
5. Vice President Keeling made a motion to receive and file Police Officer Brian Niese's resignation notification effective February 18, 2011. Commissioner Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
6. The motion to receive and file Police Officer Christopher Carter's notification of retirement effective February 28, 2011 was made by Secretary Frederick, seconded by Vice president Keeling and carried unanimously.
7. Vice President Keeling made a motion to receive and file Fire Captain Gregory Galich's notification of retirement effective April 1, 2011. Commissioner Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
8. Police Chief Morrissey presented Father James Braun with an award for his 17 years of service as Chaplain for the Kenosha Police Department. Father Braun stated he is both honored and proud to have been associated with the Department.

Fire Chief Thomsen:
  - With his 26 years of experience, retiring Captain Gregory Galich will be missed.

Police Chief Morrissey:

- Police Officer Christopher Carter is the first African American to retire from the Kenosha Police Department.
- Police Officer Brian Niese is leaving the department to take a different direction in life.

- Commissioner Schumacher thanked the Police and Fire Departments for continuing to do a fine job, particularly during the recent blizzard.

At 8:10 a.m., on a motion made by Secretary Frederick and seconded by Vice President Keeling and carried, the Board of Police & Fire Commissioners went into closed session under authority of Section 19.85 (1)(c) to discuss the appointment of three (3) individuals to Probationary Fire Fighter and the promotion of three (3) Fire Department employees; under Section 62.13(5) to discuss withdrawing the complaint against Police Detective Russell Beckman AND under authority of Section 19.85(1)(i) to discuss any other business under authority of the Commission. On role call, all members were present.

The board reconvened into open session at 9:16 a.m. on a motion made by Secretary Frederick, seconded by Vice President Keeling and carried unanimously.

Vice President Keeling made a motion to postpone withdrawing the complaint against Police Detective Russell Beckman and to reschedule his disciplinary hearing to March 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.







Detective John Gregory is retiring from the Kenosha Police Department as of March 1, 2011. Of course you know that and also know that if "Biscuit" has his way and good health he'd probably continue his career a little longer – and what a career it's been.

In mulling this over I started to pull together examples of good work John did but then I was reminded of another friend whose career ended perhaps a bit too soon because of his health – a solid, reliable Michigan State Police detective who day-in and day-out performed competent work without much fanfare. Then one day he came across a young man smoking a "joint" who just happened to be the son of a United States Senator and he received more attention from that almost accidental arrest than he did in more than two decades of prior dedicated service. The lesson there is that it isn't the case that counts but the person.

The "Biscuit" I know was one of those competent, reliable, solid people who did his job without much fanfare. Those of us who worked with John, though, took notice of the number of abused children he helped and the cases he helped build against those responsible for the abuse. John would look for what was needed to make the case and wasn't afraid to ask questions or learn new things. He cared about the cases and the people involved in them – and that often included suspects. It was not unlike John to ponder whether the punishment fit the crime or whether the suspect was really guilty. John believed in justice and wasn't afraid to share his opinions, respectfully.

The thing that stands out the most, however, is that John took other officers under his wing, guiding new talent – even in his last few months on the job. He was there to answer questions, offer advice and help a "newbie" learn the ropes – and he did it with patience and collaboration.

As you know, the citizens of Kenosha are losing a valuable asset with John's retirement but his work continues because of the questions he asked, the victims he helped and the younger officers he helped guide in their careers.


