RE: Cell Tower Funds

The City of Kenosha Board of Park Commissioners has approved cell towers in Anderson Park and Simmons Athletic Field, with the condition that these funds be placed in a special account. The funds received are receipted to a "Park & Sport Field Fund" for use in the park system.

The 2009 receipts totaled \$44,866.34, of which \$21,672.00 was used to purchase three (3) John Deere TX Gators. The current receipts for 2010 through March total \$11,476.50. These would leave a balance of from 2009 and current 2010 of \$34,670.84.

The Park Division is requesting permission from the Board of Park Commissioners to purchase a Landa: Industrial-Duty, Self-Contained Gas-Powered, Hot Water Pressure Washer with a trailer. We have received a quote from Wisconsin Steam Cleaner in the amount of \$12,500. The equipment will be used at Anderson Park for several operations including the cleaning of the pool and deck. It will also be able to handle the graffiti and maintenance of the skateboard plaza.

We will attempt to have the amount budgeted for a pressure washer, \$4,000 for the next priority at the Park Division. We will be requesting the funding to install an automatic gate for security purposes at our buildings. This gate will be similar to those that are installed at the Street Division and Service Garage.
