

PUBLIC SAFETY & WELFARE COMMITTEE
- MINUTES -
Monday, March 29, 2010

The regular meeting of the Public Safety & Welfare Committee was held on Monday, March 29, 2010 in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 5:53 pm. The following members were present: Chairman Downing, Alderman Ruef, Carpenter, and Orth. Alderman Casey was excused. Staff members in attendance were Kevin Risch & Assistant Police Chief Brydges.

It was moved by Alderman Ruef, seconded by Alderman Orth, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on Monday, March 8, 2010 and the special meeting held on March 15, 2010. Motion passed 4-0.

B-1. Proposed Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Section 4.07, Entitled "Penalties" as Section 4.08; and to Create Section 4.07, Entitled "Artificial Light & Glare".
Public Hearing: Alderman Holland was present and spoke.
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman Carpenter, to approve. Motion passed 4-0.

C-1. Aldermanic Request for Trial for Intersection Yield Control on 55th Avenue in the NB/SB Direction at 28th Street. (District 5)
It was moved by Alderman Carpenter, seconded by Alderman Orth, to approve a 90 day trial. Motion passed 3-1, with Alderman Ruef voting nay.

C-2. Aldermanic request to Designate North side 77th Street along 5710 and 5700 as No Parking Standing Stopping Any Time. (District 15)
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman Carpenter, to approve a 90 day trial. Motion passed 4-0.

C-3. Aldermanic Request for Trial for 1 Hr Parking on 56th Street from Sheridan Road to 11th Avenue and on 10th Avenue from 55th Street to 57th Street. (District 2)
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman Carpenter, to deny. Motion passed 4-0.

C-4. Previous Trials for Yield Controls:
a. EB Yield Control for 17th Avenue and 16th Avenue (District 1)
b. Yield Control for 38th Avenue and 60th Place (District 11)
c. SB Yield Control for 35th Court and 85th Place (District 14)
d. SB Yield Control for 11th Avenue and 62nd Street (District 2)
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman Carpenter, to approve. Motion passed 3-1, with Alderman Ruef voting nay.

C-5. Previous Trials for No Parking:
a. Change 2 Hour Parking to No Parking Police Vehicles Only on the north side of 55th Street from 11th Avenue - 13th Avenue (District 7)
b. Remove No Parking On School Days / 1:30pm – 3:30pm, north side of 73rd Street from 39th Avenue - 40th Avenue (District 14)
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman Carpenter, to approve. Motion passed 4-0.

SUBJECT: School Request to install No Left Turn or Thru Traffic/Right Turn Only 7am - 7:30am on School Days restriction for EB 87th Place at 30th Avenue. (District 9)

Tremper High School is requesting a No Left Turn or Thru Traffic/Right Turn Only 7am - 7:30am restriction be installed for the eastbound 87th Place at 30th Avenue.

After reviewing the previous access changes at this intersection it is believed removing the cross traffic option for the morning commute to school would be a safer alternative. This would also address complaints of residents on 87th Place in the 3000 block.

Staff recommends approval for trial.
