At roll call, the following members were present: Alderpersons Juliana and Ruffolo. Alderpersons Bogdala and Wicklund were excused. Deputy City Attorney Matt Knight and special counsel Steve Cain were present.

5. Policy & Procedure For Disciplinary Actions Relative To Taxi Driver's License.

b. License Investigations. The following may initiate requests for investigations before the Committee which may result in orders, suspensions, nonrenewals, delays in License Issuance or revocation:

The Mayor;

The Common Council;

The Committee;

The State of Wisconsin;

An Alderman;

The Police Chief;

The City Attorney; and,

Any resident of the City of Kenosha.

Requests for investigations shall contain a brief statement of the alleged misconduct. The request shall be forwarded by the requesting party to the City Clerk who shall place said request on the Common Council Agenda for referral to the Committee or directly on the Committee Agenda with the permission of the Committee Chairperson. The City Clerk or the Committee Secretary shall order the Licensee to attend the Committee meeting at which said matter will be reviewed. Documents which form a basis for a request for an investigation shall be available for the inspection of the Licensee.

The Committee may reconsider any evidence or argument presented or made before it, whether or not obtained in or related to the written request for an investigation.

The Committee, upon requesting and receiving a recommendation from the City Attorney's Office, shall recommend to the Common Council:

(1) That no action be taken;

(2) That the License shall be suspended, not renewed or revoked following Statutory notice and opportunity to be heard, where the criteria for such action in Subsection D. is met;

(3) That an order be issued and served upon the Licensee requiring that certain action be taken as a condition of maintaining said License and providing notice that revocation may be the penalty for failure to strictly comply with the letter and spirit thereof.

The Committee shall have the obligation of notifying the Licensee of any further proceedings before the Common Council.

The Common Council may affirm, deny or modify any recommendations of the Committee.



At about 6:50AM, on Wednesday, March 30th of this year, a man decided to pull up to the drive-thru window of where I work. (Dunkin' Donuts) We are not allowed to take orders at the pick-up window. Customers are to pull around to the drive-thru speaker and place their order, there. As I walked over to the window, our drive-thru alert dinged and so I stopped to take the order, as we have a time limit in which we are to completely service each customer, in the drive-thru.

It took only 45 seconds to place the order (we have a timer to monitor our progress) and in that time, the man had gotten impatient and was honking his horn at me. I kept signaling to him that I needed a moment and he only got more irritated. When I was able to open the window and inform him that he needs to go around to the speaker, he cut me off and asked if my supervisor was in. I told him "Yes, sir. But--" he had cut me off, again, to tell me that he needs to speak to a supervisor.

I tried telling him that I cannot have them come to the window to speak to him, at this time. He said "Well, I need to speak to a supervisor."

I told him "I am sorry, sir, I need you to pull around to one of the parking spaces in front of the store and I will let them

know that--" He told me "Alright, well I need them to come to the door."

At this point, our drive-thru time was very poor and we were getting a line, so I informed him of this and advised him, once more to pull around. He told me that he needs my supervisor to come to the door for him and, again, I informed him that he needs to pull around, because we were getting busy.

At that moment, he yelled, profusely, that he was going to, in a couple minutes but I was being a "nasty little bitch" to him. Then he yelled "You're the devil!" and pulled around to the front. The next two cars, both, asked me if I was alright and voiced their discomfited toward his behavior.

As he pulled off, I wrote down his license plate number, with the intent to report his unruly and highly inappropriate behavior towards me. I took note of the writing on the door of his van, with the name and number of the cab service that he works for, however, I did not commit the name to memory.

Later that day, I'd looked up possible companies and called the one that stood out to me. When the woman answered, I stated that I would like to report a driver for inappropriate behavior, but first, I wanted her to look up the license plate number, to make sure that I had the right company. The greeting had me pause, before saying "Hello, I'm calling to speak to someone about one of your drivers, but just to make sure, I would like --" As I was speaking, he snarled another, impatient "Hello?" and cut me off to ask "What did he do??" I attempted to ask that he first look up the license plate number, but was interrupted, again, with the same question, more forcefully than before.

Again, I told him "I would like you to look up the license plate number, first, to make sure I have the right company. I have the number, right here."

He said "You want me to see if it's one of ours?"

Before I could answer, he asked "How am I supposed to do that?? What did he do??" Another pause, then

I answered his first question "By looking up the license plate number." He said "Well, what's the number?? Do you even have it?" "Yes, sir. I have it, right here." I told him. "Well, then, give it here!"

I started to recite off the number "K...T...9--"

He interrupted me and said "K??? K-what???"

"K, T, 9, 8, 8, 3" I said. I can tell that he did not even bother checking and had no intent to look up any number I gave him. Again, he spat "What did he do??"

I ~~began telling him~~ asked ~~if~~ if I could speak to the manager and he said "I am the manager!" I began telling him what happened and he cut me off to tell me that he was sorry, his friend had died and he was having a bad day. I was not

under the assumption that the person I was speaking to was anyone but him, as he was just ~~as~~ as cantankerous as before.

I told him that my supervisor informed me of his situation and while that is sad, it is completely unacceptable for him to be acting in such a manner. He corrected my gentle wording and stated "I called you the devil. That's right. Because you were being a bitch to me when I was having a hard day." I informed him that I was not being a bitch, that I was doing my job and he was being unreasonable.

From this point in the call, until I asked for the number for his supervisor, and ~~the~~ after, this man was ~~still~~ arguing the same argument. He refused to be anything but petulant with me, and when I asked for his supervisor's number, he refused and yelled "No, I will not give you my supervisor's number!" and continued to argue, now saying that this whole thing is just childish, that I need to learn to ~~to~~ just let it go, because I am the devil.

So, I told him, in my most pleasant sounding voice "Okay! Well, then, I will have to find your supervisor myself. Thank you, sir and have a great day!" And hung up.

I looked up the address, with the intent to go in to confront the man about contacting his supervisor. I was not able to do so, because my boyfriend pointed out that this man was not rational and therefore, is likely to lash out and physically hurt me.

Not once, the entire day, did I raise my voice to ~~the~~ this man, call him names, or use any vulgarity. Still, this man was disrespectful, vulgar, petulant, unprofessional on many levels, and beyond reason. My boyfriend made an excellent case. Now, I am writing this statement, in hopes that something will be done to keep this man in line, because he is not fit to be transporting people around town.

NOW COMES John Morrissey, Chief of Police, Kenosha Police Department, City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and hereby states and complains as follows:


1. I am a state certified law enforcement officer presently employed by the City of Kenosha Police Department. I am currently the Police Chief;
2. At all times material hereto, Sharon Wienke d/b/a Pro Towing, hereinafter "Licensee", was licensed by the City of Kenosha Approved Towing Service for purposes of Class I, II and III tows in the City of Kenosha;
3. That Licensee was initially granted a Towing Service License, hereinafter "License", by the Common Council for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, hereinafter "Council", on January 24, 2014, pursuant to Section 13.12 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Kenosha;
4. That the Licensee's License has been renewed annually by the Council with its most recent renewal occurring on June 1, 2015, subject to a nonrenewal revocation hearing;
5. That Section 13.12 N. of the Code of General Ordinances provides that a tow service who violates the provisions of Section 13.12 shall be subject to revocation, termination or suspension of their License;
6. That upon investigation by the Kenosha Police Department, documented by the inspection report dated May 20, 2015, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1, it was determined that the Licensee has operated its storage facility contrary to the terms of Section 13.12 B.8., by failing to maintain its storage lot with a completely enclosed six (6) foot high fence;

7. That Licensee's violation of Section 13.12 B.8. subjects Licensee to revocation, termination or suspension of its License.




