SPONSOR: THE MAYOR

TO DESIGNATE THE KENOSHA NEWS AS AN ELIGIBLE NEWSPAPER TO PUBLISH MATTERS REQUIRED TO BE PUBLISHED BY THE CITY THROUGH MAY 31, 2014 PURSUANT TO SECTION 985.06 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 985.06 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Union Co-Operative Publishing Company is the official city newspaper for the City of Kenosha by virtue of the contract between the City of Kenosha and Union Co-Operative Publishing Company which is on file with the City Clerk/Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the term of the existing contract between the City of Kenosha and Union Co-Operative Publishing Company is for the period of June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City was notified on Wednesday May 7, 2014 that the Union Co-Operative Publishing Company has ceased publication thereby leaving the City without an official city newspaper for publication of matters required to be published by the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 985.06 (4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, if for any reason the City is without an official city newspaper, matters required to be published shall be published in a newspaper eligible under Section 985.03 of the Wisconsin Statutes, designated by the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the Kenosha News is a newspaper eligible under Section 985.03 of the Wisconsin Statutes to publish matters required to be published by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council wishes to designate the Kenosha News as an eligible newspaper to publish matters required to be published by the City at not more than the legal rate for like work through May 31, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, that pursuant to Section 985.06 (4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Kenosha News is hereby designated as an eligible newspaper to publish matters required to be published by the City of Kenosha at a rate not more than the legal rate for like work through May 31, 2014.
