

**ORDERS:**



**TO RENUMBER SUBSECTION 1.06 Y TO 1.06 Z; AND TO CREATE  
SUBSECTION Y OF THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES FOR  
THE CITY OF KENOSHA REGARDING KENOSHA HOMETOWN  
HEROES COMMISSION**

The Common Council of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

**Section One:** Subsection 1.06 Y of the Code of General Ordinances for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, is hereby renumbered as 1.06 Z.

**Section Two:** Subsection 1.06 Y of the Code of General Ordinances for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, is hereby created as follows:

**Y. Kenosha Hometown Heroes Commission.**

**1. Title.** There is hereby created the “Kenosha Hometown Heroes Commission”.

**2. Purpose.** Every year men and women of the City of Kenosha proudly serve in our military, preserving the freedoms and democracy that our country provides. The purpose of the Commission shall be to identify and recognize as Hometown Heroes, worthy men and women who have served or are currently serving in the United States Armed Forces who were born in, currently reside in or have previously resided for ten (10) years or more at anytime, in the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin.

**3. Members.** There shall be seven (7) members: one (1) shall be an alderperson, with preference given to an alderperson who is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces when possible, six (6) shall be adult residents of the City of Kenosha, four (4) of which shall be veterans of the United States Armed Forces. All members shall be appointed by the Mayor and

confirmed by the Common Council.

**4. Term.** The term of the members shall be two (2) years commencing on September 1. The terms shall be staggered and the initial term will be September 1, 2014, shall be as follows: One (1) member who is an alderperson shall serve for two (2) years; three (3) citizens, two (2) of which are veterans shall serve for two (2) years; three (3) citizens, two (2) of which are veterans shall serve one (1) year. There shall be no limit on the number of consecutive terms of members.

**5. Officers.** The Mayor shall appoint a chairperson and the Commission shall elect a vice-chairperson from its members. The Mayor may appoint a City employee to act as secretary for the Commission at no additional compensation to be paid to said employee other than compensatory time off unless such compensation is authorized in advance by the Common Council.

**6. By-Laws.** The Commission may, from time to time, adopt bylaws and rules of procedure fixing the time and place of meeting, prescribing the manner of keeping records and treating other matters.

**7. Duties.**

- a. To comprise a list of Kenosha's Hometown Heroes.
- b. To review nominations provided by the public to identify Kenosha's Hometown Heroes who will be recognized quarterly at regular meeting of the Common Council.
- c. To select a Hometown Hero of the year and recognize that person at the last regular meeting of the Common Council of the calendar year in which they are selected.

**Section Three:** This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.

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**Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation**

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The Complaint of the City Clerk/Treasurer for the City of Kenosha seeking the suspension or revocation of the above captioned license came before the License and Permit Committee on March 24, 2014, and May 28, 2014.

The members of the Licensing/Permit Committee present for the hearing on May 28, 2014 were Chairman Curt Wilson, Patrick Juliana, and Kurt Wicklund. Alderpersons G. John Ruffolo and David Bogdala were excused.

The Licensing/Permit Committee was represented by special counsel, Steven M. Cain.

The City Clerk/Treasurer was represented by Deputy City Attorney Matthew A. Knight.

The Licensee appeared in person by its Attorney Terry Rose.

NOW THEREFORE, based on the testimony and evidence received at the hearing, the arguments of counsel for the City, the arguments of the Licensee, and the discussion by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, the Licensing/Permit Committee of the Common Council of the City of Kenosha makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Dina Kattoum, hereinafter "Agent", is the named agent on the City of Kenosha Alcohol Beverage License Application, and was at all times relevant herein, an adult resident of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and as of November 11, 2011, resided at 9709 - 56<sup>th</sup> Street, Kenosha, WI, 53142.

2. Licensee was initially granted a Class "A" Beer license, hereinafter "License", by the Common Council for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, hereinafter "Council", on March 5, 2012, for the premises located at 2207 - 60<sup>th</sup> Street, Kenosha, Wisconsin, without being subject to demerit points;

3. On June 3, 2013, the Council granted renewal of said License;

4. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Motasem Abdeljaber, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Dina Kattoum, for No Licensed Operator on Licensed Premises, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.32(2), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 7, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court on February 20, 2014.

5. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Musa Abdeljaber, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Dina Kattoum, for No Licensed Operator on Licensed Premises, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.32(2), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7. and 10.063 E.9. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 15, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on February 20, 2014;

6. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Alexis Hoff, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Dina Kattoum, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 22, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on February 20, 2014;

7. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Motasem Abdeljabar, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Dina Kattoum, for Sale of Alcohol to

an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7. and 10.063 E.9. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on October 17, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on February 20, 2014;

8. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a municipal citation issued to Licensee's employee, Sonia Rodas, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Dina Kattoum, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7. and 10.063 E.9. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 6, 2014, with a pending municipal court pretrial date in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court;

9. That Licensee's agent and employees have violated Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 more than two (2) times within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days;

10. That Licensee has accumulated two hundred (200) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days pursuant to Section 10.063 of the Code of General Ordinances;

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.1. of the Code of General Ordinances, two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to a mandatory sixty (60) day suspension of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

12. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.2. of the Code of General Ordinances, more than two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to mandatory nonrenewal or revocation of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

13. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.3. of the Code of General Ordinances, the accumulation of one hundred (100) demerit points subjects the Licensee to nonrenewal, revocation and/or suspension of said License held by Licensee, as determined by Council.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Based on the allegations of the Complaint, the evidence and testimony received at the hearing, the arguments of Counsel for the City of Kenosha, the discussions by the members of the

Licensing/Permit Committee, and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth above, the Licensing/Permit Committee recommends to the Common Council, by a vote of 3-0, that the Class "A" Beer License of 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Mobil, Inc. be revoked.



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**Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation**

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The Complaint of the City Clerk/Treasurer for the City of Kenosha seeking the suspension or revocation of the above captioned license came before the License and Permit Committee on March 24, 2014, and May 28, 2014. That matter was adjourned on March 24, 2014, with no evidentiary hearing held.

The members of the Licensing/Permit Committee present for the hearing on May 28, 2014 were Chairman Curt Wilson, Patrick Juliana, and Kurt Wicklund. Alderpersons G. John Ruffolo and David Bogdala were excused.

The Licensing/Permit Committee was represented by special counsel, Steven M. Cain.

The City Clerk/Treasurer was represented by Deputy City Attorney Matthew A. Knight.

The Licensee appeared in person by its Agent, Gurinder Nagra.

NOW THEREFORE, based on the testimony and evidence received at the hearing, the arguments of counsel for the City, the arguments of the Licensee, and the discussion by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, the Licensing/Permit Committee of the Common Council of the City of Kenosha makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. That Gurinder Nagra, agent of 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Mobil, Inc., hereinafter "Licensee", at

all times relevant herein, was and is an adult resident of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and as of May 2, 2013, resided at 3776 Cypress Lane, Franklin, Wisconsin;

2. Licensee was initially granted a Class "A" Retail Beer License, hereinafter "License", by the Common Council for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Council", on May 20, 2013, to be effective July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, pursuant to Chapter 10 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin;

3. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Jagjit Singh, and one companion citation issued to Gurinder Nagra, the Licensee's agent, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 20, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on November 13, 2013;

4. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Jagjit Singh, and one companion citation issued to Gurinder Nagra, the Licensee's agent, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7. and 10.063 E.9., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 22, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on November 13, 2013;

5. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Amanpreet Singh, and one companion citation issued to Gurinder Nagra, the Licensee's agent, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 30, 2013, and resulting in a

conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on December 12, 2013;

6. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's agent, Gurinder Nagra, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on December 17, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on January 8, 2014;

7. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee Sukhdev Singh, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Gurinder Nagra, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on January 14, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on March 12, 2014;

8. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee Sukhdev Singh, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Gurinder Nagra, for No Licensed Operator on Licensed Premises, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.32(2), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on January 14, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on March 12, 2014;

9. That Licensee has accumulated two hundred fifty (250) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days pursuant to Section 10.063 of the Code of General Ordinances;

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

10. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.3. of the Code of General Ordinances, the accumulation of one hundred (100) demerit points subjects the Licensee to nonrenewal, revocation and/or suspension of said License held by Licensee, as determined by Council.

11. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.1. of the Code of General ordinances, two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to a mandatory sixty (60) day suspension of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

12. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.2. of the Code of General Ordinances, more than two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to mandatory non renewal or revocation of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Based on the allegations of the Complaint, the evidence and testimony received at the hearing, the arguments of Counsel for the City of Kenosha, the discussions by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth above, the Licensing/Permit Committee recommends to the Common Council, by a vote of 3-0, that the Class "A" Beer License of 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Mobil, Inc. be revoked.



The members of the Licensing/Permit Committee present for the hearing on May 28, 2014 were Chairman Curt Wilson, Patrick Juliana, and Kurt Wicklund. Alderpersons G. John Ruffolo and David Bogdala were excused.

The Licensing/Permit Committee was represented by special counsel, Steven M. Cain.

The City Clerk/Treasurer was represented by Deputy City Attorney Matthew A. Knight.

The Licensee appeared in person by its Owner, Daksha Patel.

NOW THEREFORE, based on the testimony and evidence received at the hearing, the arguments of counsel for the City, the arguments of the Licensee, and the discussion by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, the Licensing/Permit Committee of the Common Council of the City of Kenosha makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. That Daksha Patel, owner of Yash, LLC, hereinafter “Licensee”, at all times relevant herein, was an adult resident of the City of Arlington Heights, Illinois, and as of April 14, 2014, resided at 1312 W. Meade Lane, Arlington Heights, Illinois;

2. Licensee was initially granted a Class "A" Retail Beer License, hereinafter "License", by the Common Council for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Council", on February 20, 2013, which was renewed for the licensing term beginning July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, pursuant to Chapter 10 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin;

3. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's agent, Shawn Josic, for Operating Without a Licensed Person on Premises, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.32(2), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on May 23, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on June 13, 2013;

4. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's agent, Shawn Josic, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on August 22, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on September 12, 2013;

5. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's agent, Shawn Josic, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on November 7, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on November 26, 2013;

6. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's agent, Shawn Josic, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9. of

the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 6, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on February 27, 2014;

7. Licensee appointed Travis Budd as Licensee's Agent, replacing Shawn Josic, approved by Council on February 19, 2014;

8. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee Paul Stewart, and a companion citation issued to Licensee's agent, Travis Budd, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9. of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on March 11, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on April 12, 2014;

9. Licensee's Agent, Travis Budd canceled his appointment as Licensee's agent by written notice filed with the City of Kenosha City Clerk's office, dated February 22, 2014;

10. Licensee nominated Joshua DeVore as successor agent, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.04(6), Council denied said appointment April 7, 2014, based upon the material police record and false application of Joshua DeVore;

11. The Licensee's License is not in force until a successor agent is appointed and approved by the Council pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.04(6)(d);

12. Licensee nominated Daksha Patel as successor agent pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.04(6), Council denied said appointment April 21, 2014, due to Daksha Patel failing to meet statutory licensing requirements;

13. That Licensee was assessed five (5) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's owner member Daksha Patel, for Sale of Tobacco to a Minor, contrary to Section 13.09 C.1. of the Code of General Ordinances, pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7.

of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on April 8, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on April 30, 2014;

14. That Licensee was assessed twenty (20) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's owner member Daksha Patel, for Operating Without a Valid Class "A" Beer License, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.04 (1), pursuant to Section 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7. of the Code of General ordinances, said violation having occurred on April 10, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on May 1, 2014;

15. That Licensee has accumulated two hundred twenty (220) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days pursuant to Section 10.063 of the Code of General Ordinances;

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

16. That Licensee, Licensee's owner manager and agent have violated Wisconsin Chapter 125 more than two (2) times within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days;

17. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.1. of the Code of General ordinances, two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to a mandatory sixty (60) day suspension of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

18. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.2. of the Code of General Ordinances, more than two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to mandatory nonrenewal or revocation of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

19. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.3. of the Code of General Ordinances, the accumulation of one hundred (100) demerit points subjects the Licensee to non renewal,

revocation and/or suspension of said License held by Licensee, as determined by Council.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Based on the allegations of the Complaint, the evidence and testimony received at the hearing, the arguments of Counsel for the City of Kenosha, the discussions by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth above, the Licensing/Permit Committee recommends to the Common Council, by a vote of 3-0, that the Class "A" Beer License of Yash, LLC be revoked.



**The Class "A" Beer License of PDQ Store #351, Kathy Loberger, Agent**

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**Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation**

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The Complaint of the City Clerk/Treasurer for the City of Kenosha seeking the suspension or revocation of the above captioned license came before the License and Permit Committee on March 24, 2014, and May 28, 2014. That matter was adjourned on March 24, 2014, with no evidentiary hearing held.

The members of the Licensing/Permit Committee present for the hearing on May 28, 2014, were Chairman Curt Wilson, Patrick Juliana, and Kurt Wicklund. Alderpersons G. John Ruffolo and David Bogdala were excused.

The Licensing/Permit Committee was represented by special counsel, Steven M. Cain.

The City Clerk/Treasurer was represented by Deputy City Attorney Matthew A. Knight.

The Licensee appeared by its Attorney, Ronald M. Trachtenberg.

NOW THEREFORE, based on the testimony and evidence received at the hearing, the arguments of counsel for the City, the arguments of counsel for the Licensee, testimony of witnesses, and the discussion by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, the Licensing/Permit Committee of the Common Council of the City of Kenosha makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation:

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. That Kathy Loberger, agent of PDQ Food Stores, Inc., d/b/a PDQ Store #351, hereinafter "Licensee", at all times relevant herein, was and is an adult resident of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, and as of March 4, 2013, resided at 8552 – 84<sup>th</sup> Street, Kenosha, Wisconsin;

2. Licensee was initially granted a Class "A" Retail Beer License, hereinafter "License", by the Common Council for the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Council", on July 1, 1992, pursuant to Chapter 10 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin;

3. On June 3, 2013, the Council granted renewal of said License pursuant to Section 10.063 G. of the Code of General Ordinances, Kenosha, Wisconsin, for the licensing period beginning on July 1, 2013, and concluding on June 30, 2014, subject to forty (40) demerit points.

4. That Licensee was assessed twenty-five (25) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Obadiah Bennett, and one companion citation issued to Kathy Loberger, the Licensee's agent, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1. and 10.063 E.7., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on September 23, 2013, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on January 21, 2014;

5. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a conviction of Licensee's employee, Samantha Crocker, and one companion citation issued to Kathy Loberger, the Licensee's agent, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on January 22, 2014, and resulting in a conviction in the Municipal Court for the City of Kenosha on February 12, 2014;

6. That Licensee was assessed fifty (50) demerit points based upon a municipal citation issued to Licensee's employee, Carolyn Krisor, and a companion citation issued to Kathy Loberger, the Licensee's agent, for Sale of Alcohol to an Underage Person, contrary to Wisconsin Statute Section 125.07(1)(a), pursuant to Sections 10.063 E.1., 10.063 E.7., and 10.063 E.9., of the Code of General Ordinances, said violation having occurred on February 6, 2014, with a pending municipal court pretrial date in the City of Kenosha Municipal Court;

7. That Licensee's agent and employees have violated Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 more than two (2) times within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days;

8. That Licensee has accumulated one hundred sixty-five (165) demerit points within seven hundred thirty (730) consecutive days pursuant to Section 10.063 of the Code of General Ordinances;

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.1. of the Code of General ordinances, two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to a mandatory sixty (60) day suspension of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

10. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.2. of the Code of General Ordinances, more than two (2) violations of Wisconsin Statute Chapter 125 within three hundred sixty-five (365) consecutive days subjects Licensee to mandatory nonrenewal or revocation of said License held by Licensee as determined by Council;

11. Pursuant to Section 10.063 E.3. of the Code of General Ordinances, the accumulation of one hundred (100) demerit points subjects the Licensee to nonrenewal, revocation and/or suspension of said License held by Licensee, as determined by Council.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Based on the allegations of the Complaint, the evidence and testimony received at the hearing, the arguments of Counsel for the City of Kenosha and the Licensee, the discussions by the members of the Licensing/Permit Committee, and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth above, the Licensing/Permit Committee recommends to the Common Council, by a vote of 3-0, that the Class "A" Beer License of PDQ Store #351 be revoked.
