Minutes of Meeting held Monday, June 9, 2014

A meeting of the Public Safety & Welfare Committee was held on Monday, June 9, 2014 in Room 204 of the Kenosha Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Chairman LaMacchia.

At roll call, the following members were present: Alderpersons Wicklund and Rose. Alderpersons Gordon and Rosenberg were excused. Staff members in attendance were: Shelly Billingsley, Deputy Director of Public Works/City Engineer; Jeff Warnock, Superintendent of Parks; Deputy Police Chief Dan Miskinis; Alderperson David Bogdala; Alderperson Steve Bostrom; Alderperson Bob Johnson; Jeff Labahn, Director of Community Development & Inspections; Debra Salas, City Clerk/Treasurer; Alderperson Patrick Juliana and Alderperson G. John Ruffolo.

It was moved by Alderperson Rose, seconded by Alderperson Wicklund, to approve the minutes from the meetings held of May 12, 2014, May 19, 2014 and June 2, 2014. Motion carried unanimously.

1. Previous Trial to Remove the 2-hr Parking from 8:00am to 6:00pm Monday-Saturday except Holidays Signs on 31st Avenue from 56th Street to 60th Street and 58th Street from 30th Avenue to 31st Avenue. *(District 11)(Staff recommends approval)*

It was moved by Alderperson Wicklund, seconded by Alderperson Rose, to approve. Motion carried unanimously.
