

Subject: **Previous Trial for the restriction of parking along the east side of 96th Avenue from 67th Street to 70th Street (District 17) (Staff Recommends a new 90-Day Trial)**

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This request has been on trial as indicated with no complaints or problems reported to Engineering Staff for the areas located adjacent to Nash Elementary School. These signs were all added to bring Nash Elementary School to meet the guidelines set forth in Ordinance 7.05© of the City of Kenosha Code of General Ordinances which requires that that 'No Parking Standing or Stopping from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on School Days' signs be installed along all road frontages adjacent to a school.


Alderperson Bogdala also requested that 'No Parking Standing or Stopping 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.' signs be installed on the east side of 96th Avenue from 67th Street to 70th Street. This has not fully alleviated the issue and still results in times where cars are parked on both sides of the road which can not support two-way traffic as it is only 27 feet wide. As a result, Alderperson Bogdala has requested that the signs on the east side of 96th Ave be changed to 'No Parking'. Attachment 1 shows the current signage located in the area and Attachment 2 shows the change requested by Alderperson Bogdala.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval for a new 90-day trial to change the 'No Parking Standing or Stopping 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.' to 'No Parking' signs on the east side of 96th Avenue from 65th Street to 70th Street.





Staff recommends approval of the restriction of parking on the west side of 35th Avenue from 60th Street to 65th Street. A new resolution will need to be created to restrict parking.


