Monday, July 26, 2010

The regular meeting of the Public Safety & Welfare Committee was held on Monday, July 26, 2010 in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 5:47 pm. The following members were present: Chairman Downing, Alderman Kennedy, Orth, Green, and LaMacchia. Staff members in attendance were Kevin Risch & Chief Morrissey.

It was moved by Alderman LaMacchia, seconded by Alderman Green, to approve the minutes of the meeting held on Monday, July 12, 2010. Motion passed 5-0.

It was moved by Alderman LaMacchia, seconded by Alderman Green, to take items C-3 through C-5 first. Motion passed 5-0.

- C-1. Proposed Ordinance To Create Subsection 1.06 Y (of the Code of General Ordinances) Entitled "Aldermanic Notice". (Also referred to Finance Committee, Public Works Committee, and Licensing/Permit Committee)
PUBLIC HEARING: Alderman Ruffolo, 4th District, explained what amendments Public Works Committee made and approved to both C-1 and C-2.
It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman Green, to approve as amended by Public Works Committee. Motion passed 5-0.

It was moved by Alderman Orth, seconded by Alderman LaMacchia, to approve. Motion passed 5-0.
- C-4. Proposed Ordinance To Create Section 13.011 (of the Code of General Ordinances) Entitled "Recycling Center Activity License".
It was moved by Alderman Green, seconded by Alderman LaMacchia, to approve. Motion passed 5-0.
- C-5. Proposed Ordinance To Repeal and Create Section 4.05 (of the Code of General Ordinances) and to Rename Section 4.05 Smoking Prohibited, Adopting Statewide Smoking Prohibition.
PUBLIC HEARING: Chief Morrissey was to answer any questions.
It was moved by Alderman LaMacchia, seconded by Alderman Green, to approve. Motion passed 5-0.

ALDERMEN COMMENTS: Alderman Orth had a constituent call him about having a family of skunks living under his house. The constituent called Animal Control twice, but the skunks are still there. 
The original parking restriction on the west side of 10th Avenue was 15 min Parking, which are outdated.



This request for no parking is to accommodate the boat storage business of Capt. Jim's on a seasonal basis while also providing for some additional on street residential parking for adjacent residents.



Alderman Carpenter is requesting to lengthen the existing no parking zone on the south side of 27th Street from 90 feet to 160 feet east of 30th Avenue.

SUBJECT: Aldermanic Request for Trial for Intersection Yield Control on 55th Avenue in the Northbound and Southbound Direction at 28th Street (District 5)

Alderman Kathy Carpenter has indicated that many complaints have been received regarding speeding vehicles and the lack of intersection control for the referenced location and has asked Public Works to determine if a Yield sign can be placed in the NB/SB direction at 28th Street.

Staff has looked at the above location and has determined that this intersection has 2 legs that are not through streets (west leg and south leg). The request is to place Yield signs on 55th Avenue for the NB/SB movements and currently the south leg is only 2 blocks long and by placing the Yield sign for this direction the unrestricted movement would be to a cul-du-sac (west leg). The NB/SB movements have good sight distances approaching 28th Street and currently there is no accident history at this location.

Although staff recognizes the concerns raised by Alderman Carpenter, we do not recommend approval of this request for reasons stated above.

Alderman Kennedy is requesting Stop control at the above intersection due to concerns being continually raised by his constituents. At present, there is no intersection control at this "T" intersection. Staff has determined that there is no accident history at this intersection to warrant stop control.
