**Minutes of Meeting held Monday, July 13, 2015**

A meeting of the Public Safety & Welfare Committee was held on Monday, July 13, 2015 in Room 204 of the Kenosha Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 5:57 pm by Chairman LaMacchia.

At roll call, the following members were present: Alderpersons Wicklund, Rose, Gordon and Rosenberg. Staff members in attendance were: Shelly Billingsley, Acting Director of Public Works; Jeff Warnock, Superintendent of Parks; Police Chief John Morrissey; Deputy City Attorney Matthew Knight; Alderperson David Bogdala and Alderperson Curt Wilson.

It was moved by Alderperson Gordon, seconded by Alderperson Rosenberg, to approve the minutes from the meeting held on Monday, June 29, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

1. Request from Patrick Zuchowski Installation of Obstruction (*Planter Box*) in the Public Right-of-Way at 6606 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. (*District 8*) (*Deferred from the meetings on 4/27/15, 5/11/15, 6/8/15 & 6/29/15*)  
Staff: Shelly Billingsley spoke.  
Public Hearing: Patrick Zuchowski spoke.  
It was moved by Alderperson Gordon, seconded by Alderperson Wicklund, to deny.  
Motion carried unanimously.
2. Request from Angela Kreuser for Obstruction (*Basketball Hoop*) in the Public Right-of-Way at 6739 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue. (*District 17*)  
Staff: Shelly Billingsley, Police Chief Morrissey, and Alderperson David Bogdala (*handed out a map for items #2 & #3*) spoke. Attorney Matthew Knight answered questions.  
It was moved by Alderperson Gordon, seconded by Alderperson Wicklund, to deny.  
Motion carried unanimously.
3. Request from Mike & Sandy Alexander for Obstruction (*Basketball Hoop*) in the Public Right-of-Way at 10800 67<sup>th</sup> Place. (*District 17*)  
Staff: Shelly Billingsley and Police Chief Morrissey spoke.  
It was moved by Alderperson Gordon, seconded by Alderperson Rose, to deny. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Previous trial for the removal of the 2 hour parking restrictions posted on 22nd Avenue between 75th Street and 76th Street. (*District 13*) (*Staff recommends approval*)  
Staff: Shelly Billingsley and Alderperson Curt Wilson spoke.  
It was moved by Alderperson Rose, seconded by Alderperson Gordon, to approve.  
Motion carried unanimously.

CITIZEN COMMENTS: Wendy Veasey spoke about the Police Dispatcher on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July being very sarcastic. Also how animal control has been at her neighbor's house all the time. Kristine Geliche from Stonefield/Walnut Grove Subdivision Neighborhood Watch has a petition for two intersections. She explained how they would like a 4-Way stop at 55<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 28<sup>th</sup> Place and on 47<sup>th</sup> Ave and 27<sup>th</sup> St. She also would like signage on 47<sup>th</sup> Ave and 24<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> St to be placed in the easement. Mrs. Geliche stated that the 27<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> resurfacing still has not been take care of. Patrick Zuchowski asked "Who is in charge of the sidewalk in the City?". He states there are big holes around Roosevelt. Mr. Zuchowski also commented on signage by Simmons Park.

STAFF COMMENTS: Police Chief Morrissey responded to Mrs. Veasey's comments. He stated that Animal Control only traps animals and they only shoot skunks. He did agree there is numerous complaints at Mrs. Veasey's neighbor and if it continues, they will have to have a special charge or get a trap. Police Chief Morrissey also commented on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and said that there were no calls by the lake front.

ALDERPERSON COMMENTS: Alderperson Wicklund asked Mr. Zuchowski to contact him about the sidewalk concerns.

ADJOURNMENT - There being no further business to come before the Public Safety & Welfare Committee, it was moved, seconded and unanimously carried to adjourn at 6:32 pm.


