1. This meeting was called to order at by President Keeling at 8:03 a.m. on Thursday, July 7, 2011. The meeting was held in room 202 of the Municipal Office Building. On roll call, commission members Peni Keeling, Ron Frederick, Helen Schumacher and Charles Bradley were present. Commissioner Greco was absent.
2. At 8:04 a.m. the board went into closed session on a motion made by Vice President Frederick, seconded by Secretary Schumacher and carried unanimously. On role call, all members were present with the exception of Commissioner James Greco.

Under authority of Section 19.85 (1)(c) the board discussed:

- The appointment of four (4) individuals to the position of Probationary Police Officer to be effective July 18, 2011 and
- the promotion of one (1) individual to the position of Interim Police Lieutenant to be effective July 16, 2011.

The board reconvened into open session at 9:05 a.m. on a motion made by Vice President Frederick, seconded by Commissioner Bradley and carried unanimously.

POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JULY 12, 2011

1. This meeting was called to order at by President Keeling at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 12, 2011. The meeting was held in room 202 of the Municipal Office Building. On roll call, commission members Peni Keeling, Ron Frederick, Helen Schumacher, Charles Bradley and James Greco were present.
2. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held June 21, 2011. Vice President Frederick seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
3. Citizen's comments:

Jack Rose, President of the National Alliance on Mental Illness spoke briefly about Crisis Intervention Training that is available at no cost to the Kenosha Police and Sheriff's Departments. There are 45 people (within the County) that have completed the training.

Police Chief Morrissey introduced Police Chaplains Dean Carlson, Jason Held, J.D. Meliar and Jeff Sackett who were in attendance.
4. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to receive and file the Police and Fire Department Reports for the month of June 2011. Vice President seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
5. Vice President Frederick made a motion to receive and file the complaint received from Malcom Butler. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

In response to President Keeling's inquiry, Police Chief Morrissey stated that Mr. Butler's concerns had previously been investigated and the matter was considered "closed".
6. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to receive and file Robert Shaw's letter of thanks sent to Police Chief Morrissey. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
7. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to receive and file Kathy Baas' letter to Police Chief Morrissey complimenting animal control officers. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

President Keeling asked Chief Morrissey if he had any comments. The Chief indicated the letter was forwarded to Paws 'n Claws because animal control is not part of the Kenosha Police Department.
8. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to receive and file the card sent to Chief Morrissey thanking him for his attendance at the annual "Blessing of the Fleet". Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

9. Vice President Frederick made a motion to approve the appointment of Joseph Gemignani to Interim Lieutenant effective July 16, 2011. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
10. Approval of the appointments to Probationary Police Officer effective July 18, 2011:
 - Secretary Schumacher made a motion to approve the appointment of Ryan W. Alles. Vice President seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
 - Secretary Schumacher made a motion to approve the appointment of Matthew T. Nolan. Vice President seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
 - Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve the appointment of Jacob L. Berghuis. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
 - Secretary Schumacher made a motion to approve the appointment of Joseph L. Kozak. Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
11. At 8:18 a.m., the Board of Police & Fire Commissioners went into closed session under authority of Section 62.13 (5) to consider the complaint against Police Chief Morrissey submitted by Russell Beckman to Commission President Peni Keeling at the June 21, 2011 Police and Fire Commission Meeting on a motion made by Secretary Schumacher, Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously. On role call, all members were present.

The Board reconvened into open session at 8:45 a.m. on a motion made by Vice President Frederick, seconded by Commissioner Bradley and carried unanimously.

The Board has found that the allegations of the citizen's complaint of Russell R. Beckman, filed with the Commission on June 21, 2011, are not sufficient to justify further action by the board. Secretary Schumacher made a motion that the complaint against the Chief of Police be received and filed. Vice President Frederick seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

12. Chiefs' Comments

Police Chief Morrissey:

- Discussed expansion of training on mental health issues. Some smaller departments may have a problem with longer training.
- Requested that a closed session meeting be held on August 10th to review 3 additional candidates for the position of Probationary Police Officer.
- Eleven (11) individuals remain on the current eligibility list. He would like to start the recruitment process soon.
- In the future, he would like to establish two (2) eligibility lists, one of certified and the other of non-certified candidates.
- During the storm of June 30th, the Public Safety Building was without power for a period of time and a small fire broke out but was quickly contained. Apparently, WE Energies did not have this building on their "priority list" but that has since been corrected.

Deputy Fire Chief Santelli:

- The Department will be receiving 2 new ambulances within the next 4 months and *tentatively*, 2 new fire trucks.
- The firefighter examination is scheduled for July 23rd.

- Over 90 calls for service were received during the last storms.

13. Commissioners' Comments:

- Commissioner Bradley commented on a July 4th accident.
- President Keeling said "keep up the good work".

14. Next meeting dates:

Secretary Schumacher made a motion to schedule a closed session meeting on *Wednesday, August 10th at 8:00 a.m.* in room 202 of the Municipal Office Building. Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to schedule the next regular commission meeting on *Tuesday, August 16th at 8:00 a.m.* in room 202 of the Municipal Office Building. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried.

15. The meeting adjourned at 9:17 a.m. on a motion made by Commissioner Bradley, seconded by Secretary Schumacher and carried unanimously.




