A meeting of the Licensing/Permit Committee was held on August 8, 2016, in Room 202 of the Kenosha Municipal Building.

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by Chairperson Curt Wilson.

At roll call, the following members were present: Alderpersons Downing, Kennedy and Fox. Alderperson Juliana arrived following roll call. Deputy City Attorney Matt Knight was present.

Citizen Comments: None.
