





My reason for writing your office at this time is to be made aware of a meeting that was held in the form of a Court hearing that I was not made aware of that took place in the month of June or July.

As a formal request that Your office Make Me aware of what transpired at that Meeting! I further would like to request the opportunity to be heard in person and to present witnesses and other evidence, and also to exercise the right to confront any adverse Accusers, if any further hearing are Held.

Presently I am in prison due to the allegations of this arrest in which I feel was illegal and unconstitutional, Errorness and an abuse of discretion. I have filed a Writ of Certiorari requesting a Judicial review which is currently pending in front of Honorable DAVID M. Bastianelli Branch 1 (Kenosha County Case # 13EP5/13CV1168 - State of Wisconsin ex rel. Renewal Glover v. David Schwarz Division of Hearings And Appeals) And My Criminal Charges in which I was revoked for 13CF202 are still pending as well.

Mr. Glover,

This letter is to acknowledge that I did receive your letter dated August 23, 2013, in reference to your concerns about your arrest and current criminal charges.

The Kenosha Police & Fire Commission did receive and file a letter from you at the meeting held on June 25, 2013. The Commission did not hold any type of hearing on the matter. The commission was informed that I believe that your issues are a matter for the judicial system. The motion to receive and file was approved unanimously. I have attached a copy of the unsigned minutes to this letter. Chapter 227 of the Wisconsin Statutes is not specific to Police & Fire Commissions, however, since no hearing was held, there are no findings of fact and conclusion of law, the only formal written documentation is the minutes from June 25, 2013.

The concerns of violations of your constitutional rights, such as you were "arrested without probable cause" are issues that the Kenosha County Circuit Court or appellate courts need to address. The issuing of warrants and a criminal complaint has been approved by the courts and you and your legal counsel need to address those issues in the judicial process.

I wish you luck in resolving your current legal issues and hope that someday you will be able to continue your ministry, however, the proper venue to address your issues is the judicial system.
