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POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD AUGUST 16, 2011

1. This meeting was called to order at by President Keeling at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 16, 2011. The meeting was held in room 204 of the Municipal Office Building. On roll call, commission members Peni Keeling, Ron Frederick, Helen Schumacher and James Greco were present. Charles Bradley was absent.
2. Vice President Frederick made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held July 7, 2011. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
3. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held June 12, 2011. Vice President Frederick seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
4. No citizens' comments.
5. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to receive and file the Police and Fire Department Reports for the month of July, 2011. Vice President Frederick seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
6. Approval of the appointments to Probationary Police officer effective September 1, 2011:
 - The appointment of Travis A. Fitzgerald was approved on a motion made by Vice President Frederick, seconded by Secretary Schumacher and carried unanimously.
 - The appointment of Adam M. Martinez was approved on a motion made by Secretary Schumacher, seconded by Commissioner Greco and carried unanimously.
 - The appointment of Kyle R. Baars was approved on a motion made by Vice President Frederick, seconded by Secretary Schumacher and carried unanimously.
 - The appointment of Martin G. Howard was approved on a motion made by Vice President Frederick, seconded by Secretary Schumacher and carried unanimously.
7. Chiefs' Comments.
 - Fire Chief Thomsen
 - Mentioned that Firefighter recruitment is underway. Oral interviews of 306 applicants will begin August 22nd.
 - The Fire Department will be fully staffed again shortly; Firefighter Daniel Tilton is returning from his one year deployment.
 - Police Chief Morrissey
 - The newly appointed Probationary Police Officers will be sworn in at 8:00 a.m. on September 1, 2011 at the Public Safety Building. Everyone is invited. These officers will begin the Police Academy at Gateway Technical College on September 7th.
 - After these officers are sworn in the Police Department will be fully staffed again with 199 sworn officers.
 - There are only 7 individuals left on the current Police Officer eligibility list. Therefore,

the Police Officer recruiting process has begun. Application deadline is September 16, 2011 and the written test is scheduled for October 15th and 27th.

- It is anticipated that at least 6 more people will be retiring by the end of 2011.
- The Chief has been chosen as one of 30 law enforcement executives from across the country invited to participate in the 15th *National Law Enforcement Leadership Institute on Violence Against Women* being held in Seattle, Washington.

Fire Chief Thomsen

- Wanted to remind everyone of the upcoming 9/11 Ceremony scheduled for 2:00 p.m. September 11, 2011 at the bandshell in Pennoyer Park. The program is estimated to last an hour and a half.

- Secretary Schumacher told everyone to keep up the good work.
- President Keeling congratulated the newly appointed Police Officers.






