5. Commissioner Kubicki made a motion to receive and file Police and Fire Department reports for the month of October 2013. Commissioner Schend seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

 - Four more retirement notices have been received.

- Commissioner Schend stated that he feels the hiring process for Police & Fire works well.
- Secretary Greco congratulated those who received recognition.




Ref: Retirement Notification

This Letter is to inform you that I will officially retire from the Kenosha Police Department at the end of the day on December 31st 2013. My official start date was May 16th. 1985. I will have completed nearly 29 years with the Kenosha Police Department.

Per past practice, I am requesting that I be allowed to purchase my issued service weapon (Glock Model 22 40 cal. Semi-Auto Serial #PHX150) for the sum of \$1.00. I am also requesting that I be paid for any unused Vacation / Holiday Time that I have accumulated PRIOR to the time of my retirement. I wish to continue receiving my family Health Insurance through the City of Kenosha, along with all other benefits entitled to me per contract with the City of Kenosha and the K.P.P.A.
