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POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD OCTOBER 18, 2011

1. This meeting was called to order at by President Keeling at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 18, 2011. The meeting was held in room 202 of the Municipal Office Building. On roll call, commission members Peni Keeling, Ron Frederick, Helen Schumacher, Charles Bradley and James Greco.
2. Vice President Frederick made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held August 10, 2011. Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
3. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held August 16, 2011. Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
4. No citizens' comments.
5. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to receive and file the Police and Fire Department Reports for the months of August and September, 2011. Commissioner Greco seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
6. Vice President Frederick made a motion to receive and file Fire Chief John Thomsen's notification of Lieutenant Brook Lagerwall's five (5) day unpaid suspension. Secretary Schumacher seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
7. Vice President Frederick made a motion to receive and file Police Chief John Morrissey's notification of Police Officer Casey Apker's two (2) day unpaid suspension. Commissioner Bradley seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
8. Secretary Schumacher made a motion to receive and file Gail Kulbacki's letter of appreciation to all the Officers who responded to her October 4, 2011 emergency call. Vice President Frederick seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
9. Chiefs' Comments.
 - Chief Morrissey
 - Police Officer testing was done on Saturday October 15th. Of the 300 or so invited, 201 showed up to test. The test will be given again on October 22nd with another 300+ invited.
 - A total of 664 Police Officer applications were received.
 - Anticipated that oral interviews will begin in early November.
 - As of right now, no retirements are pending and the department is fully staffed.
 - Explained proposed staffing changes within the Kenosha Police Department for 2012.
 - Asked the Commission if they would like to suggest revisions of the monthly Police Department reports provided to the Commission.

Chief Thomsen

- Firefighter applicants will be completing CPAT testing November 7th, 8th and 9th.
- With the resignation of EEO Coordinator Timothy Thompkins, another Human Resources employee will be assigned to handle the H.R. functions for the Fire Department.

10. Commissioners' Comments.

- Secretary Schumacher thanked both Chief Morrissey and Chief Thomsen for their participation in the 911 remembrance ceremony. Secretary Schumacher recently attended a "Blood Stain Pattern Conference" and found it very educational.






