PLUMBING INFORMATION

1. WHEN IS A PLUMBING PERMIT REQUIRED?

Permits are required for all new and all replacement fixtures, drains, vents, water systems, sanitary sewer taps and drain lines, storm water sewer taps and drain lines, and water service lines.

2. WHAT REGULATIONS MUST I MEET?

All work performed must be in accordance with Chapters 80-87 of the Wisconsin Plumbing Code.

3. WHO CAN PERFORM PLUMBING WORK?

All plumbing work shall be performed by a Wisconsin-licensed Master Plumber, Journeyman Plumber, or a registered Apprentice Plumber.

4. HOW DO I OBTAIN A PERMIT?

If your work is being completed by a licensed plumber, he/she will be responsible for obtaining all plumbing permits. However, it is the property owner's responsibility to verify a plumbing permit has been obtained and a final inspection has been successfully completed by the plumbing inspector.
