Acer tataricum	Tatarian Maple	ovate	15' – 25'	15' – 25'	Low growing species appropriate for planting under wires – tree form
Acer x freemanii “Jeffersred”	Autumn Blaze Maple	broadly ovate	50' – 60'	40' – 50'	Celebration, Scarlet Sentinel, Armstrong cultivars also acceptable
Amelanchier	Serviceberry species	broadly ovate	20' – 30'	15' – 20'	Several cultivars available – tree form
Betula nigra “Heritage”	Heritage River Birch	ovate	40' – 50'	30' – 35'	Single stem tree form
Carpinus betulus	European Hornbeam	ovate	35' – 40'	20' – 30'	Fastigiate tree form
Carpinus carolinena	American Hornbeam	ovate	20' – 35'	20' – 35'	
Celtis occidentalis	Hackberry	broadly globose	40' – 50'	40' – 50'	
Cercis canadaensis	Eastern Redbud	broadly ovate	25' – 30'	25' – 35'	Needs a broad parkway for best results
Cladrastis kentukea	Yellowwood	broadly ovate	35' – 50'	40' – 55'	
Corylus columna	Turkish Filbert	conical	45' – 60'	25' – 35'	
Crataegus	Hawthorn	broadly ovate	15' – 35'	10' – 35'	Thornless cultivars – Needs a broad parkway for best results
Ginkgo biloba	Ginkgo	irregular	50' – 80'	40' – 80'	Male clones only, upright cultivars also available (Princeton Sentry)
Gleditsia triacanthos	Honeylocust	broadly ovate	40' – 80'	35' – 65'	Size depends on cultivar,
Gymnocladus dioicus	Kentucky Coffeetree	irregular ovate	55' – 75'	45' – 65'	Shedding of pods can be a cleanup problem
Liriodendron tulipifera	Tuliptree	conical to ovate	70' – 90'	35' – 50'	Broad parkway required
Malus speices	Flowering crabapple	various	10 – 35'	10 – 25'	Choose disease resistant cultivars;i.e Red Jewel, Prairiefire
Phellodendron amurense	Macho Amur corktree	broadly ovate	35' – 45'	30' – 40'	Male clones only
Platanus x acerifolia	London Planetree	broadly ovate	70' – 80'	55' – 65'	Broad parkway required, fruit litter nuisance
Pyrus calleryana	Callery Pear	broadly ovate	30' – 45'	25' – 35'	Aristocrat, Autumn Blaze, Chanticleer or similar cultivar
Quercus bicolor	Swamp White Oak	broadly ovate	60' – 80'	50' – 80'	drought, salt tolerant, acorn litter nuisance broad parkway
Quercus rubra	Northern Red Oak	broadly ovate	60' – 80'	45' – 65'	Urban tolerant, acorn nuisance, broad parkway
Syringa reticulata	Japanese Tree Lilac	ovate	20' – 30'	15' – 20'	Ivory Silk is a superior cultivar
Tilia americana “Redmond”	Redmond Linden	conical	50' – 70'	30' – 45'	
Tilia cordata	Littleleaf Linden	ovate	60' – 80'	35' – 55'	Greenspire is a superior cultivar
Tilia tomentosa	Silver Linden	broadly conical	60' – 70'	45' – 55'	Seems to be less susceptible to Japanese Beetle leaf damage
Ulmus cultivars	Elm	vase shaped	50 – 75'	30' – 70'	Broad parkway required, select Dutch Elm disease resistant cultivar

ovate	Elliptic to egg-shaped
globose	Rounded circular form
conical	Appearing triangular in outline
irregular	assymetrical, uneven outline
