2009 REFORESTATION PROGRAM

Beginning on Monday, January 5, 2009, the City of Kenosha Park Department is offering the citizens of Kenosha the opportunity to purchase street trees to be planted in the area between the sidewalk and curb. Orders are taken on a first-come, first-served basis until the end of January.

The site will need to meet the criteria as outlined by City Ordinance. If your site qualifies, your order will be processed and information with an order form will be sent in late February.

Payment and the order form will need to be returned no later than April 13, 2009. Trees are approximately 9 feet to 12 feet in height and there will be several varieties available. The trees will be planted by Park Division staff during the growing season of 2009. While we will attempt to plant the tree of your choice, this is not always possible and a substitution may be necessary.

The cost per tree is \$25.00 for a replacement, which is for a tree that has been removed in the past five years and \$100.00 for new trees.

If you are interest in purchasing a tree, call the Park Division Field Office at 653-4080 beginning on Monday, January 5, 2009. Orders will be taken Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:15 am and 2:45 pm.
