

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Public Works of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin in the office of Department of Public Works, Room 305, 625 52nd Street, Room 305, until **10:00 AM., local time, Friday, August 22, 2008**, for furnishing all labor and materials necessary for the construction of:

Strawberry Creek Surface Paving Project #08-1024

all in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Works. This project consists of paving surface course, adjusting manholes, miscellaneous curb and gutter repair and other incidental items. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately after **10:00 AM.** Each bid must contain the full name of every person or company interested in the same and must be accompanied by a contract and bid bond, a certified check, or a bank cashier's check, in the sum of five per cent (5%) of the bid, payable to the City of Kenosha as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured within fifteen (15) days of the award of contract. Should any bid be rejected, such check will be forthwith returned to the bidder, and should any bid be accepted, such check will be returned upon the timely and proper execution and securing of the contract. In case the successful bidder shall fail to execute the contract and performance bond, the amount of the bid bond or check shall be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages.

Plans and specifications will be furnished upon application, and a **NON REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT (CASH OR CHECK ONLY)** paid to the Department of Public Works, of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

Any contractor desiring plans and specifications **BY MAIL** shall submit, in addition, a separate check for \$6.00 covering handling and mailing charges. This money will not be returned.

The form provided for "Bidder's Proof of Responsibility" shall be completed and returned to the Director of Engineering not less than five (5) days before the date of bid opening.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish Worker's Compensation and Liability Insurance as enumerated in the specifications.

In the event that Section 66.0903 of the Wisconsin Statutes, applies, on the work here bid upon, the Contractor shall pay to each of his/her workers the wage prevailing in Kenosha at the time the contract is entered into and as listed and filed in the office of the Director of Public Works. A copy of such wage rates will be incorporated in the contract documents.

The City of Kenosha reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid considered most advantageous to the City of Kenosha.
