GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Yardwaste must be free of debris.
- Residents must de-bag their own yardwaste if not a city-approved biodegradable bag.
- Sod is accepted – separate from other yardwaste – Limit 1 Can per visit.
- Brush up to 12' lengths & 6" diameters. No need to be bundled.
- There is no weight limit.
- Residents must unload their own items from their vehicles.
- **NO** Tree Stumps, Bush Roots, Food Waste, Garbage, Wreaths, Pumpkins, Holiday Decorations, or Wood Chips are accepted.
- **Wednesdays** are Senior Citizen's/Disabled Person's Day—Additional staff will be available to help anyone who may need assistance.
- **FREE** compost & wood chips may be available during normal business hours. However citizens must bring their own shovels, containers and load the materials themselves.
- Compost can be delivered for a fee when available. Contact the Street Division for details.
