### GENERAL GUIDELINES

- **DO NOT** recycle empty oil bottles. Put them in regular garbage.
- **Acceptable Oils are:**
  - 2-Cycle Oil
  - Crankcase Oil
  - Diesel Fuel
  - Fuel Oil
  - Gear Lube
  - Hydraulic Oil
  - Lubrication Oils
  - Motor Oil
  - Transmission Oil
- **Unacceptable items are:**
  - Cleaning Solvents
  - Cooking Oils
  - Gasoline
  - Industrial cutting oils
  - Transformer or Heat transfer Oils



- Unaccepted Oils can be taken the Household Hazardous Waste Site. See [www.kenoshawater.org](http://www.kenoshawater.org) for information, hours & location.
- Used oil filters can be disposed of at the Waste Division or Street Division.
