

YARDWASTE COLLECTION

Yardwaste is banned from Wisconsin landfills. The best thing you can do with your yardwaste is to compost it or use it as mulch at home. Grass clippings can be left on the lawn, where they provide nutrients for your turf. Clippings & leaves also make excellent mulch in gardens and around flowers and shrubs.

These bags are available at your local retail, hardware, & grocery stores. No other bags are accepted.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Collected in Spring & Fall. Exact dates are announced in the newspaper, radio, Cable TV Channel 25, and the recycling calendar. For exact dates see the recycling calendar.
- Yardwaste will be collected on your regular garbage day.
- Limit 40 lbs per bag.
- Collected curbside & **must** be in city-approved biodegradable bag.
- Place yardwaste bags a few feet away from your regular garbage and recycling items.
- **DO NOT** mix yardwaste with garbage or recyclables.
- **Acceptable items are:**
 - Branches (pencil size or smaller)
 - Garden plants
 - Grass clippings
 - Leaves
 - Pine cones/needles
 - Tree seeds
 - Shrub trimmings
 - Weeds
- **Unacceptable items are:**
 - Cemetery wreaths
 - Cornstalks
 - Decorations
 - Floral arrangements
 - Food waste
 - Pumpkins
 - Rhubarb stems
 - Tree nuts
 - Wood Chips
