BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

- Call 262.653.4050 at least one business day prior to your regular garbage day.
- Collected on the same day as your regular garbage day.
- Maximum 5 cubic yards or 30 bags per collection.
- Limit 10 bags, cans, or bundles of building/demolition material.




GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Place items at the curb the evening before or no later than 6:30 am on your collection day.
- Keep bulk items in a separate pile from your regular garbage.
- Keep away from trees, utility poles, mail boxes, traffic signs, fire hydrants & parked cars.
- During winter months, bulk items must be free of ice and snow on the bags and set out in a cleared area at the curb (e.g. driveway approach).
- Items must fit in a truck opening of 4'x4' and two people must be able to lift items waist high.
- No loose materials accepted. Make sure small items are contained in a bag, garbage can or bundled.
- Carpet, Padding and Rugs must be rolled in 3' sections and tied or taped. No heavier than 40 lbs.
- Windows can be no larger than 4'x4'. Tape an "X" with heavy duty tape across the glass on both sides to prevent breakage.
- Paneling, plywood, drywall and plasterboard must be in 4'x4' or smaller sections. Lumber, PVC or metal piping must be in 3' lengths. Pull out or bend over nails. No more than 40 lbs per bag, can or bundle.
- **DO NOT** Mix recyclables or yardwaste with garbage.
- **DO NOT** put any items in cardboard boxes.
- **Unacceptable items are:**
 - Hazardous or Liquid Waste
 - No Tank of any type (e.g. propane, oxygen, gas, etc) unless cut in half
 - Pianos, Organs, Cast Iron Bathtubs, or Glass Patio Doors
 - Camper Tops, Truck Caps or Boats
 - Concrete, Stone, Brick, Asphalt, or Masonry
 - Sand, Dirt, or Clay

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- City Residents & Residential Property Owners ONLY.
- Proof of residency and/or ownership required.
- A ticket must be purchased for each cubic yard of debris (see next page).
- No vehicle larger than a pickup truck or small trailer allowed.
- User(s) must off-load bulk waste on their own.
- Items must fit down a 4'x4' chute.
- Children under 12 and pets must remain in vehicle.
- Attendant can refuse service for any rule violation.
- **NO** loose material accepted. Garbage must be contained.
- **NO** recyclables or yardwaste can be mixed in.
- **NO** tips, gratuities or refunds.
- **Unacceptable Items are:**
 - Hazardous or Liquid Waste
 - No Tank of any type (e.g. propane, oxygen, gas, etc) unless cut in half
 - Pianos or Organs
 - Camper Tops, Truck Caps or Boats
 - Concrete, Stone, Brick, Asphalt or Masonry
 - Sand, Dirt, or Clay
- **FREE** Drop-Off Items that do not need a bulk ticket:
 - Bare Wood
 - Car Batteries
 - Electronics (whole units)
 - Scrap Metal
 - Auto & Small Truck Tires (up to 4 per visit)
