Kenosha Police Officer Struck by Vehicle

A Kenosha Police Officer was struck by a vehicle this morning around 6:00 a.m. at the intersection of 63rd Street and Sheridan Road. The officer was attempting to open stop signs that are attached to the traffic light poles due to a loss of power after a vehicle struck a utility pole at 50th Street and Sheridan Road, causing a power outage, around 4:16 a.m. The driver of the vehicle remained on scene and is cooperating with the Wisconsin State Patrol, who responded to investigate the accident.

According to the State Patrol, the driver will likely be cited for failing to yield the right of way to a pedestrian and for illegal tint on the vehicle's front windows.

The officer, a 4-year veteran of the Kenosha Police Department, was treated and released from a local hospital.

As a result of the accident, the intersection at 63rd Street and Sheridan Road was closed for approximately 3 hours.
