KENOSHA – The Jeff Stevens Tribute Band will headline “Ralph Houghton's Let Freedom Sing” at the Pennoyer Park bandshell from 6:30-9 p.m. July 4. The free concert precedes the Festival Foods Fireworks at 9:30 p.m., and is sponsored by the City of Kenosha, the Kenosha News and Renwood Messenger Studios.

Lead by John Anderson, the Jeff Stevens Tribute Band was formed from the vestiges of the Lonely Ninjas, one of the many bands Stevens joined over the years. The band stays true to their former bandmate, playing at least one unoriginal original and always at least one Tom Petty song.

The Oscillators opens the evening’s performance, with a show from 4:30-6 p.m. The Oscillators are a unique group that combines a mix of genres and styles, creating something unique, fun and contagious.
