KENOSHA – There will be no curbside garbage, recycling, brush, tire, or bulk collection on Thursday, July 4, 2024 in recognition of the Fourth of July holiday.

Collection will be delayed one day for Thursday and Friday only. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday will have a normal pickup schedule. Regular collection schedules will resume the week of July 8, 2024.

The Bulk Drop-Off Site, 1001-50th Street, is CLOSED on Mondays and Holidays. It will re-open on Saturday, July 6, 2024 its usual hours of operations from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The Yard Waste Drop-Off Site, 4071-88th Avenue (HWY H), will be CLOSED Thursday, July 4, 2024. It will re-open on Friday, July 5, 2024, for usual hours of operations from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The Concrete/Brick Drop-off Site, 6415 35th Avenue, will be closed on Thursday, July 4, 2024. It will reopen on Friday, July 5, 2024 for usual hours of operations from 7 a.m. – 3 p.m.
