KENOSHA - Swimming is banned at three lakefront parks, due to poor water quality following heavy rainfall on Monday, July 15. Testing of samples showed poor water quality Tuesday, July 16 at Eichelman and Southport Parks and swimming was banned. On Wednesday, July 17 the ban was extended to include no swimming at Simmons Island park. The beaches remain open, but citizens are advised to avoid contact with the water.

The City will continue to provide updates as testing of the water quality is repeated.
