KENOSHA – A man reportedly posed as an employee of the Kenosha Water Utility on Tuesday with the intent of entering a customer's home on the City's north side, under the false pretense of poor water quality.

The resident did not allow the man into his home and contacted his alderperson.

Kenosha Water Utility General Manager Curt Czarnecki said similar schemes have been used in the past for theft within the targeted home. He said employees of the Kenosha Water Utility will present utility issued identification if they need to access private property.

"Whenever a Kenosha Water Utility employee visits a home they will be driving a vehicle clearly marked as a water utility vehicle, they will be wearing clothing that contains the utility name and logo and they all have been provided a utility issued ID that contains their photo," Czarnecki said.
