KENOSHA – When you drink Kenosha tap water, you’re drinking clean, high quality water. Kenosha’s drinking water meets or exceeds all state and federal water quality standards. The Kenosha Water Utility’s state certified laboratory tests Kenosha’s drinking water more than 10,000 times per year. The results of the tests are summarized in the consumer confidence report (CCR).

The 2023 CCR Data that is required by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is available in many locations, including local libraries, museums, Kenosha County Health Department, and community centers such as the Boys & Girls Club of Kenosha, Salvation Army, Shalom Center, St. Mark’s Outreach Center and Kenosha Achievement Center.
